

PRIVACY POLICY

WE RESPECT YOUR PRIVACY

We are committed to ensuring the privacy of all our users at the onedaypoll.org website.

This Privacy Policy governs all pages on our website. It does not apply to third party websites. Our website may be linked to the websites of such other parties but those other sites may have their own privacy policy which applies to them.

Our website may be used without entering personal information. Different rules may apply to certain services on our website, however, and are explained separately below. We collect personal information from you (e.g. your phone number, email) in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR). The provisions below serve to provide information as to the manner, extent and purpose for collecting, using and processing personal information by the provider.

Please be aware that data transfer via the internet is subject to security risks and, therefore, complete protection against third-party access to transferred data cannot be ensured.

USE OF RECAPTCHA

In order to protect input forms on our site, we use the "reCAPTCHA" service of Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043 USA, hereinafter "Google". By means of this service, it can be distinguished whether the corresponding input is of human origin or is created improperly by automated machine processing.

To our knowledge, the referrer's URL, the IP address, the behaviour of the website visitors, information about the operating system, browser and length of stay, cookies, display instructions and scripts, user input behaviour and mouse movements in the "reCAPTCHA" checkbox are conveyed to "Google."

Google uses the information obtained, among other things, to digitize books and other printed matter as well as to optimize services such as Google Street View and Google Maps (e.g. house number and street name recognition).

The IP address provided as part of "reCAPTCHA" is not merged with other data from Google unless you are logged into your Google Account at the time the "reCAPTCHA" plug-in is used. If you want to prevent "Google" transmitting and storing data about you and your behaviour on our Website, you must log out of "Google" before you visit our site or before using the reCAPTCHA plug-in.

COOKIES

Our Website makes use of so-called cookies in order to recognize the repeat use of our Website by the same user/internet connection subscriber. Cookies are small text files that your internet browser downloads and stores on your computer. They are used to improve our Website and services. In most cases these are so-called "session cookies" that are deleted once you leave our Website.

To an extent, however, these cookies also pass along information used to automatically recognize you. Recognition occurs through an IP address saved in the cookies. The information thereby obtained is used to improve our services and to expedite your access to the Website.

You can prevent cookies from being installed by adjusting the settings of your browser software accordingly. You should be aware, however, that by doing so you may not be able to make full use of all the functions of our Website.

SERVER DATA

For technical reasons, data such as the following, which your internet browser transmits to us or to our web space provider (so called server log files), is collected:

- type and version of the browser you use;
- operating system;
- websites that linked you to our site (referrer URL);
- websites that you visit;
- date and time of your visit;
- your Internet Protocol (IP) address.

This anonymous data is stored separately from any personal information you may have provided, thereby making it impossible to connect it to any particular person. The data is used for statistical purposes in order to improve our Website and services.

PURPOSE OF REGISTERING

We offer you the opportunity to sign up for our Website. The information entered when signing up, as shown in the registration form, is collected and stored solely for use by our Website. When signing up for our Website, we also store your IP address and the date and time you registered. This serves to protect us in the event of an improperly and without your knowledge use of your data by a third party to sign up for our Website. None of this information is transferred to third parties except email addresses that may be passed on to third parties for newsletter purposes (see the NEWSLETTER section below).

When registering, we ask you to confirm that you accept the privacy policy and agree with it. By checking the corresponding box, you confirm your consent to the fact that your personal data will be processed in accordance with the privacy policy of our Website, and also confirm that you have reached the age of 16.

Personal data received for sending newsletters will be stored until the moment when the registration is canceled by the person who provided the data. Newsletter distribution may be terminated. In this case, the personal data collected for these purposes will be destroyed.

NEWSLETTER

Registration on the Website (when you indicate the country of residence and e-mail address) means that you consent to subscribe to our newsletter. The newsletter provides you periodically with information about our services, events, new videos etc. To receive our newsletter, we require a valid email address and country of residence. We will review the email address you provide for the purpose of determining whether you are in fact the owner of the email address provided or whether the actual owner of the provided address is authorized to receive the newsletter. When subscribing to our newsletter, we will store your IP address as well as the date and time you subscribed. This serves to protect us in the event of an improperly and without your knowledge use of your email address by a third party to subscribe to our newsletter. We will not collect any other data. The data thereby collected is used solely for the purpose of receiving our newsletter. None of this information is matched to any information that other components of our Website may collect. You may cancel your subscription to the newsletter at any time. You will find additional details in the email confirming your subscription as well as in each following newsletter.

For the purpose of sending newsletters, personal data (e-mail) can be transferred to a third party without further notice of the person who provided their data. In this case, only email is transmitted to the third party. None of the other personal data obtained during registration on the Website or in the process of using it will be transferred to the third party. The transfer of personal data (e-mail) to a third party is carried out in accordance with the rules established by the GDPR.

CONTACTING US

On our Website we offer you the opportunity to contact us by email onedaypoll@gmail.com. In this case, information provided by the user is stored for the purpose of facilitating communications with the user. No data is transferred to third parties.

USE OF GOOGLE ADWORDS

For purposes of promotion, our Website also employs the Google ad tool "Google Ads". As part of this, our Website employs the analysis service "Conversion Tracking" from Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043 USA, hereinafter referred to as "Google". If you access our site through the Google ad tool, a cookie will be placed on your computer. Cookies are small text files that your internet browser downloads and stores on your computer. These so-called "conversion cookies" cease to be active after 30 days and are not used to identify you personally. If you visit certain pages of our Website while the cookie is still active, we and Google will know that you, as a user, have clicked on ads placed by Google and were redirected to our site. Google uses the information obtained through "conversion cookies" to compile statistics for our Website. These statistics tell us the total number of users who have clicked on our ad as well as which pages of our Website were then accessed by each user. However, neither we nor other advertisers who use "Google Ads" receive any kind of information that can be used to personally identify users. You can prevent the installation of "conversion cookies" by making the appropriate change to your browser settings, for example by setting your browser so that the automatic placement of cookies is deactivated or by blocking cookies from the domain "googleadservices.com".

USE OF GOOGLE ANALYTICS WITH ANONYMIZATION

Our Website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service from Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043 USA, hereinafter referred to as "Google". Google Analytics employs so-called "cookies", text files that are stored onto your computer in order to facilitate an analysis of your use of the site.

The information generated by these cookies, such as time, place and frequency of your visits to our site, including your IP address, is transmitted to Google's location in the US and stored there.

We use Google Analytics with an IP anonymization feature on our Website. In doing so, Google abbreviates and thereby anonymizes your IP address before transferring it from member states of the European Union or signatory states to the Agreement on the European Economic Area.

Google will use this information to evaluate your usage of our site, to compile reports on website activity for us, and to provide other services related to website- and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties if this is required by law or to the extent this data is processed by third parties on Google's behalf.

Google states that it will never associate your IP address with other data held by Google. You can prevent cookies from being installed by adjusting the settings on your browser software accordingly. You should be aware, however, that by doing so you may not be able to make full use of all the functions of our Website.

Google also offers a disabling option for the most common browsers, thus providing you with greater control over the data which is collected and processed by Google. If you enable this option, no information regarding your website visit is transmitted to Google Analytics. However, the activation does not prevent the transmission of information to us or to any other web analytics services we may use.
